



On behalf of the **SABNES** Board of Directors and the **Shuswap Naturalist Club**, thank you for your support regarding the recent bird box vandalism. We are happy to report that it has ended.

We were truly overwhelmed and inspired by the outpouring of offers to help, as well as the many generous donations. The destruction of bird boxes, active nests, and the killing of a mother swallow on her nest obviously hit a nerve. With the help of the **Shuswap Trail Alliance** and the **media**, word travelled across Canada, sparking outrage and action. **BC Nature Trust**, who owns the foreshore land that **SABNES** manages, set up a **CanadaHelps.ca** fundraising page and offered to send their staff to help on-site. A **\$1000** reward has been posted by the **Gardom Lake Stewardship Society**.

Thanks to the forty individuals and organizations who contributed a total of \$8,508 for restoration. Eight game cameras are now strategically mounted to oversee the birds, and volunteers connected with **Makerspace** have constructed forty new bird boxes. **Shuswap Naturalist Club** volunteers hope to use any extra boxes to replace some of the old ones near **Peterson's Orchard** to create a 'bluebird trail', which they would also maintain. Funds will also go toward installation of longer, stronger posts after the Lake recedes and nesting is over.

SABNES is in the process of rebuilding the bird viewing platform on the foreshore that was destroyed in high water two years ago. Our volunteer crew salvaged much of the timber from the existing structure to use to build the new one. Some of the donated funds will also help to complete this project. We have an engineered plan in the works and are in the process of hiring a qualified contractor. Volunteers will help with initial labour and some of the finishing carpentry.

Thanks again for your generous donations and all your volunteer time.

Bird Viewing Platform -near Christmas Island has been dismantled with care to preserve any good timber.

Permission Granted: The City of Salmon Arm will begin an upgrade of the wettest part of trail this fall. SABNES was able to secure permission for this from FLNRO (BC Ministry of Forest Lands, Natural Resource Operations). We were also granted permission to rebuild the bird viewing platform. Work will begin in August.
